WINTER 2017/18 QUALIFIER/TEAM DATES

Show Jumping team friendly – 11th November at Elstead club field Team of three (can include one junior), each jump one round at a different height: 75, 85, 95cm

National Winter Novice Show Jumping Qualfier - 12th February at Sands Farm

Senior and Junior qualifiers, two rounds of which first round at 80cm (no BS points)

National Winter Intermediate Show Jumping Qualifier - 3rd March at Berkshire College of Agriculture

Three separate competitions:

90 SJ - for senior teams and junior teams of four riders, and individuals (horse no more than 20 BE and/or 500 BS points) 100 SJ - mixed class open to teams that can be any combination of seniors and juniors, and individuals (no more than 60 BE and/or 999 BS points)

110 SJ - mixed class open to teams that can be any combination of seniors and juniors, and individuals (no limit on points) *Please note: a horse/pony can only compete at one height (i.e. 80 or 90 or 100 or 110) and cannot enter more than one winter SJ qualifier.*

It was a busy day starting for our first competitor at 10:20 and not due to finish till after 6pm. Each team consists of 4 riders, 2 riding prelim tests and 2 riding novice tests. Elstead RC entered 3 teams.

Our Elstead White team of Emma Kampa (Nyton Good Friday), Suzi Stanner (Out of Your League), Barbara Barnard (Cantlease Kestrel) and Grace Jackson (Sweet Opposition) winning and qualifying for the Championships with Emma 3rd and Barbara 5th in their individual arenas.

London & South East Championships - 24 September 2017

Elstead members had a very successful day at this year's championships held at Munstead.

The Elstead blue team of Holly Stuart (So Sue Me), Emma Kampa (Nyton Good Friday), Hannah Jackson (Brownbread Raven) and Melanie Lusted (Keeshen Jazmine) won the dressage championship, with Melanie 2nd, Emma 3rd, Hannah 3rd and Holly 4th in their individual arenas. Our white team of Suzi Stanner (Out Of Your League), Karen Merrifield (Togher Tourist), Annie Denton (Malingold Mercury) and Allison Kite (Quinlan) finished in ninth place out of 18 teams.

The Elstead team of Holly, Annie, Suzi and Emma was 3rd in the riding test championship. Annie was individual 4th in arena 5 and Holly individual 6th in arena 6.

Our horse trials team of Allison, Melanie, Marion Spencer (George Bailey) and Hannah Jackson (JJ) finished tenth out of the 17 teams taking part. Marion and Melanie were both 4th in their individual arenas.

Elstead's show jumping team of Jenny Cheetham (Lumiere Gorm), Isabel Bailey-Collins (Solero Spirit), Jessie Drake (Chilli) and Clara Jollands (Lily) was 5th. Clara jumped double clear and so went into the jump off for individual places and was rewarded with 2nd place.
