# Clear Round Show Jumping - 11th February 2017

### National Winter Novice Show Jumping Qualifier - 12th February 2017

We entered two senior teams for this qualifier held at Sands Farm on 12th February and both teams finished the two rounds with just four faults. There were two other teams with no faults who jumped off (with Abinger Forest taking first place) and then five teams tying for third place on four faults and so the time taken in the second round was used to work out the lower placings.

The Elstead 'blue' team of Allison Kite (Quinlan), Jenny Cheetham (Mattie) and Hannah Jackson (Raven) were 6th, and the Elstead 'red' team of Jenny Dutton (Liberty Flower), Clara Jollands (Lily), Steph Gray(Chunky Monkey) and Isabel Bailey-Collins (Solero Spirit) were seventh. Well done to all our team members and particularly Clara, Isabel, Jenny C and Hannah who all jumped double clears. Thank you to everyone who took part and also to those who came along to support our teams.

### **New Team Show Jumping Competitions**

The former 'novice', 'intermediate' and 'open' show jumping competitions have been replaced with different competitions which offer more options. For the summer qualifiers for the national championships which take place at Lincoln, there are now five separate qualifiers with first round heights of 70cm, 80cm, 90cm, 100cm or 110cm. The second round would increase by 5cms for each. There are separate junior and senior competitions for each of the 70, 80 and 90. For the 100 and 110, teams can include any mix of seniors and juniors. The same horse can only do one competition. For the 70, the horse must not have any BS or BE points.

### **Dressage to Music**

The qualifiers for both National and London & South East DTM championships will take place on 16th July at Plumpton College. Classes (which are for individuals not teams) are senior novice DTM (split into 0 BD points at Novice or above, or with points), junior prelim DTM, junior novice DTM, elementary DTM (for both juniors and seniors) and a 'pick your own test' which is a mixed class for senior and junior individuals competing at medium or advanced medium level. There is also a pairs DTM (mixed class for seniors/juniors). For the L&SE champs there are also qualifiers for 'pas seul' (individual DTM in costume) and 'pas de deux' (pairs DTM in costume).
