BRC NAF National Championships – 1st & 2nd September 2018

Elstead members had a great time at these championships at Lincolnshire showground. We had twenty seniors and four juniors taking part in most of the jumping and/or dressage championships, with seniors competing on Saturday and juniors on Sunday. Great results all round:

Show jumping 90 team 2nd: Helen Klein (individual 5th), Emily Weeks, Suzi Hopkins and Jenni Crow.

Show jumping 80 team 3rd: Bridget Naylor, Jenny Dutton, Clara Jollands and Isabel Bailey-Collins. Clara was the individual champion, with Isabel individual 8th.

Show jumping 70 team of Jaz Merrifield, Emma Kampa (riding Bert), Allison Kite and Juliet Hamm finished outside the top ten due mainly to time faults but all were pleased with how their horses jumped as it was the first time in this competition for all four.

Style jumping team 8th: Isabel Bailey-Collins, Emma Kampa (Bert) Emily Weeks and Jenny Dutton. Clara Jollands qualified as an individual in the 75cm style jumping and was 4th.

Senior riding test team 5th: Holly Stuart (Sue), Melanie Lusted, Barbara Barnard and Katie Patrick. In their respective arenas, Holly was individual 1st and Melanie 8th in the Prelim RT, and Barbara was individual 6th in the Novice RT.

Senior prelim dressage team 10th: Holly Stuart (Sue), Debby Booth, Emma Kampa (Ernie) and Melanie Lusted. Melanie was individual 8th.

Katie Patrick qualified as an individual in the Novice 30 of the Open Dressage and was 5th.

Senior pairs dressage 3rd: Marion Spencer and Katie Patrick

We entered two teams for the senior team of four dressage (all four in the arena at the same time!). Just one mark separated our two teams (with Chipstead's team sandwiched between Elstead's teams on the same mark as the red team but with lower collective marks)! The ERC 'red' team of Angharad Talbot, Bridget Naylor, Karen Merrifield and Marion Spencer was 4th and the ERC 'blue' team of Holly Stuart (Mickey), Emma Kampa (Ernie), Barbara Barnard and Debby Booth 6th.

Several Elstead members made direct entries to the individual veteran dressage classes. In the Veteran Horse class, Holly was 7th on Mickey and Melanie 8th on Jazmine. Marion was 10th in the Veteran Rider.

Sunday was a very successful day for our juniors: Sydney Aldred (Jimmy), Lily Amero (Jumpingdale Cleo), Annabelle Tavener (Bonnie) and Callie Rickwood (Flashman). All four competed in both the 70 show jumping and the junior team of four dressage. Practise paid off in the junior team of four dressage - all four rode accurately with good spacing throughout to be rewarded with 4th rosettes.

Sydney, Lily and Callie also competed in the junior style jumping, with Sydney and Lily in the 75cm section and Callie in the 85cm section. All three jumped nice style rounds with just the odd pole down to finish just outside the rosettes in 12th place.

The junior show jumping 70 was the highlight of the weekend. The first round was in the same arena as for the senior SJ70, while the second round was in the bigger ring used for the senior SJ80. The Elstead junior team finished the first round on just 8 faults, and then went on to finish the second (higher) round with no faults. This looked really good and the commentator said there didn't need to be a team jump off but the results would not be announced until after an individual jump off and help with clearing all the jumps from the arena. All four jumped at least one clear round but Lily jumped double clear and so went into the individual jump off where a fast clear earned her 2nd place. Thanks to help from Elstead members and supporters in clearing the arena, it wasn't too long before the Elstead team was announced as the 2018 Junior 70SJ Champions! A great end to a really enjoyable weekend.

Huge thanks to those who filled our helper slots at Lincoln: Mark Aldred (SJ arena party) and Julie Tavener with some help from Annabelle and Sydney (dressage score sheet collecting) on Saturday; Emma Kampa (riding test writer) and Katie Patrick (dressage writer) on Sunday. Well done to our team of Isabel Bailey-Collins (Solero Spirit), Heidi Reed (Ilar Vincent), Clara Jollands (Lily) and Emily Weeks (Monta Mystic Clover) who were placed 8th in this year's Riding Club Challenge 90 at Blenheim. The drawn order had put Elstead to go late morning and all our team members jumped really well, finishing inside the very tight time with just four faults. Only one club jumped clear and the top ten teams had just four faults or less. Where there was equality of faults it was down to which team was nearest the optimum time and it wasn't until the last of the 40 teams had finished that Elstead knew how well they had done. This was our best result yet at this event and particularly satisfying as we were balloted out last year.
