

Team members are also automatically competing as individuals, and individuals can also enter if not in a team. There are separate junior and senior teams, four in each team and each team member rides a different test: Prelim 13, Novice 28, Novice 34 and Elementary 42. There is also an individual 'pick a test' competition which is Medium 71 or Advanced Medium 90.

## **Reports**

### AGM Report - 23.11.2018

We had a good turnout for our AGM on 23rd November. The evening started with light refreshments (thank you to everyone for the delicious nibbles) and a slide show of photos of members taking part in various activities thanks to Charlotte Holder. The formal business meeting highlighted the events, training and other activities run during the year as well as the club's finances. The opportunity to take part in teams is open to all members and one third of our members represented Elstead in 2018, doing very well at local and national level. Of the 58 members who represented the club this year, 11 (mostly new members) were riding in an Elstead team for the first time. Our club has again retained the Foss Trophy for the Club in our area with the most points in teams – now the 22nd year in succession and the 25th time in total that Elstead has won this trophy (although we never take it for granted)!
