Good luck to those who have qualified for the **London & South East Championships** on 6th October – we are sending one dressage, one riding test and two show jumping teams to Snowball Farm. There is a new individual Intro qualifier for the **Novice Winter Championships** – separate qualifiers for juniors and seniors. These will take place at Priory, Frensham on 19th October – entries to Wey Valley RC. Entry fee is £16 to WVRC and in addition a pre-entry has to be made to British Riding Clubs which will cost £9.50 – please ask Penny if you need more information about how to enter this qualifier.

Festival of the Horse qualifiers take place at Heath Farm, Munstead on Sunday 13th October. These include the Challenge (a round of SJ and then straight out onto the XC course at 80, 90 or 100) and Combined Training (dressage and show jumping). Qualifiers and Championship Event Reports

National Horse Trials Championships 2019

Congratulations to Laura Tugwell, our only member to compete at this year's national horse trials championship, for a brilliant 4th place in her arena in the 90HT.

Many thanks to Emma Kampa, Jacky Kampa and Penny Jann who very kindly went to Swalcliffe to help steward the Roads & Tracks phase for the 90 HT (so catching a glimpse or two of Laura on her way round Phase C). By helping at the horse trials they reduced the number of helpers needed from our club at the Lincoln championships.

National Championships - Lincoln 2019

Many thanks to those who volunteered to be our helpers at Lincoln: Heidi Reed, Karen Merrifield, Simon Jollands, Claudine Lawes, Freya Lawes, Julie Tavener, Mark Aldred and Pippa Harrison who each spent half a day on the Saturday filling various roles including dressage/riding test writing/stewarding and jumping arena party. Without your support our teams would not have been able to compete at these championships.

Nineteen senior and nine junior Elstead members travelled to Lincoln to compete in this year's national championships (taking a total of 33 horses between them!) which is the most competitors we have ever had at Lincoln. Seniors competed on Saturday and juniors on Sunday although there were several direct entry individual classes on both days.

Senior results:

Our riding test team was 2nd (out of 31 teams!): Holly Stuart (riding Ruby Cameron's So Sue Me), Melanie Lusted (Keeshen Jazmine), Joanne Tuccio (April) and Emily Weeks (Monta Mystic Clover). Each rode in a different arena: Joanne was individual 1st in Arena 3, Holly was 2nd in Arena 1 and Melanie was 8th in Arena 3.

Our preliminary dressage team was 2nd – Emma Kampa (Ernie), Melanie Lusted, Debby Booth (Woodrow The Farrier) and Lauren Fenn (Spot-On). As well as the team members, several other ERC members had qualified as individuals – all competed in different arenas and came home with rosettes: Emma was 8th in P12, Melanie 6th in P13, Debby 2nd in P14 and Lauren 4th in P15. Jazmine Merrifield (Togher Tourist) was 7th in the individual P13 arena, and Melanie was 2nd in the individual P12 arena. Our open dressage individuals -Barbara Barnard (Kestrel) in N24 and Sara Malpass (Basil) in N34 - were both placed 6th.

At the pairs dressage qualifier the top two pairs had the same scores and were separated by just 0.5 of a technical mark. After the initial disappointment of so nearly qualifying, we were very surprised and pleased when British Riding Clubs gave Emma Kampa (Dylan) and Sara Malpass (Ernie) a wild card entry to the championships. Despite a heavy downpour while doing their test, the pair kept together beautifully to be rewarded with 6th place.

Quite a number of our members entered the direct entry classes and those in the top ten of their respective classes. Emma (riding Bert) was 4th in the native pony dressage, Melanie was 4th in the veteran horse dressage, Holly was 5th in the coloured horse dressage, and Jenny Dutton (Liberty Flower) was 8th in the veteran rider dressage.

The show jumping courses were definitely championship quality, with all courses including both a double and a treble, even for the 70cm, and set at maximum height and width. Our 70SJ team members Hannah Jackskon (Belle), Allison Kite (Brooks), Juliet Hamm (Grey Alley) and Emma Kampa (Bert) each had at least one good round but the team (along with a number of other clubs' competitors) were eliminated. Of the 59 competitors who completed, Hannah was unlucky to miss out on an individual top ten place by just one second but delighted with her young horse's debut at a championship.

Emily Weeks (Sky), Suzi Hopkins (Max), Jessie Drake (Hilton) and Helen Klein (Limerick) were 7th in the 90SJ, with Helen individual 6th. Emily (riding Monta Mystic Clover) and Helen (riding Darcos Glory) also jumped in the Area 11 100SJ team, along with a Bookham member and a Chipstead member, helping the Area team to 4th place.

Our style jumping team members Emma Kampa (Bert), Jenny Dutton (Flower), Clara Jollands (Lily) and Helen Klein (Limerick) was placed 10th, with Clara individual 3rd in the 85cm style jumping section. Clara also jumped as an individual in the 80SJ but a couple of poles down put them out of the top ten.

Junior results:

Oliver Austin (Corclough Ifle), Callie Rickwood (Flashman), Betsy Pullen (Glenvar Fionn) and Millie Harrison (Lyre Sea Mist) were 5th in the junior 80SJ team and 6th in the junior style jumping team. Callie was individual 6th in the 75cm section of the style jumping.

William Austin (Yealand Verse), Pippa Reed (Linley Spirit – a late substitution as Ted had pus in a hoof), Sydney Aldred (Jimmy) and Annabelle Tavener (Kerry Gold) were 9th in the 70SJ.

Lily Amero (Darcy) rode as an individual in the junior 90SJ and jumped really well to finish on just 4 faults. There were only three double clears (and quite a few eliminations) in the junior 90SJ and Lily was unlucky to miss out on a top ten place by just a few seconds.

Callie, Pippa and Sydney also represented Elstead in the dressage and riding test, joined in the dressage by Millie and in the riding test by Lily. Although there were some lovely comments from the judges, our teams were not in the ribbons on this occasion.

Well done to all our members who took part in these championships and who were a credit to our club.
