Help Save our Riding Routes!

The British Horse Society wants us all (riders, cyclists, walkers) to check our off-road routes against the Definitive Map which can be found at your local library, council office or on-line. The BHS urgently wants to know of any unrecorded routes which you currently or have previously used. Official records of all missing routes not currently on the Definitive Map must be logged before 2026. While this may seem a long time away, it takes time to identify and confirm paths, particularly those that have been in place before 1949 as they may not be registered as a right of way. From 2026 any unrecorded path will cease to exist as a right of way and can be boarded up. For more information visit www.bhs.org.uk/2026



The BHS Level One Award in Essential Horse Knowledge

This was a 6 week course taken by Heidi Reed (BHSI). It was a theory course based on the BHS stage 1. It covered a wide range of fascinating subjects about the basic care and management of a horse including health and safety on a yard, recognising the signs of good and ill health in a horse, buying a horse, the costs of keeping a horse and looking at horse behaviour.

We bought my daughter her first horse when she was 13 and my husband and I were not from a horsey background. My daughter, having been through Pony Club, Riding Club and with help from a knowledge livery yard, had all the knowledge and I just picked up information where I could. This course gave me the opportunity to ask all sorts of questions and listen to other people's experiences under Heidi's expert guidance and knowledge. We had time to talk through all sorts of areas and where we wanted to, to go above and beyond the syllabus. Heidi brought the course to life by bringing in all sorts of things like different foods and bits to show us practical examples and not just theory. I found it extremely interesting and useful. There is even an optional exam to gain your Essential Horse Knowledge Certificate.

I would recommend this to anyone who wants to understand more about horse care and to ask questions in a friendly environment.
